



# CAMPER'S HOLIDAY CAMPGROUND

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Welcome to Camper's Holiday. To make your stay more enjoyable, please observe the following rules:

1. Deposits: Remaining \$150 deposit will be forfeited if reservation commitment is not fulfilled, i.e., camper leaves early.
2. Park on paved portion of site. Pads must be placed under all jacks.
3. One (1) RV per site and maximum of two (2) additional vehicles on paved area if space permits.
4. Utility trailers, car dollies, etc. must be parked in designated area at the upper end of the campground along fence behind store. No parking of any type vehicle along other fence area.
5. PETS are welcome but must be under control and on a leash at all times. Two (2) pets per site. No barking dogs. ALWAYS clean up after your pet and properly dispose of all waste, including in Pet Exercise Area. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required. Except for ADA, Title II and III, service dogs, pets are not permitted in buildings, pavilion, or swimming pool area.
6. Auto repairs or oil changes prohibited in campground.
7. Only RV patio mats may be placed on your campsite area, not to exceed size of awning.
8. Speed limit is 10 mph at all times in all areas of the park.
9. Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
10. Check out time is 11:00 AM.
11. Registered guests are responsible for the conduct of everyone in their party. There is a day charge of five dollars (\$5.00) for each additional guest 18 years or older. If you are expecting guests, please notify the gatehouse attendant. If guests arrive after gatehouse hours, you are responsible for admitting guests.
12. Follow all Hernando County water restriction rules.
13. Coin laundry facilities available. Hours are 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. No dying permitted. Do not overload machines. If a machine does not operate properly, please place a sign on it and notify gatehouse personnel.
14. No business shall be conducted in the campground.
15. No nails or screws in trees. Hangers or hooks on pantries only.
16. Campfires are NOT allowed on individual sites. No fireworks, firecrackers, or illegal drugs permitted.
17. Swimming pool hours are 9:00 a.m. to dusk. NO lifeguard in attendance. Children under twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult. Please observe all rules listed in the pool area. Call 911 for emergencies.
18. All buildings, shelters, and pool areas are NO SMOKING areas. Dispose of butts properly.
19. Enjoy Lake Sparkman for fishing or boating. Florida fishing regulations apply. Boat motors limited to 3.0 electric. Florida laws prohibit feeding the alligators. We recommend catch & release only.

20. Owners who wish to store their RV or other equipment during the off season summer months must move all equipment to the designated storage area before leaving the campground. Owner will be responsible for moving all equipment in and out of storage. Camper's Holiday employees are not permitted to move RV's or other equipment. All unattached steps, sewer/water lines, etc. must be removed and properly stored by the owner.
21. Owners of unoccupied RV's on a campsite, other than a designated storage site, will pay the designated lot rate, not lesser storage rate fee.
22. All RV units must be road worthy. Camper's Holiday reserves the right to refuse entry to any RV deemed to be in poor condition.
23. When the owner of a unit presently in the campground transfers ownership to another individual, the Board of Directors, or representative thereof, will determine, based on RV condition, whether the unit may stay in the campground.
24. Camper's Holiday reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual, and to evict person (s), without refund, for failure to abide by any of the above rules and regulations and for behavior detrimental to the campground.
25. Park facilities are used at your own risk. Camper's Holiday assumes no responsibility for accidents or injuries of any kind to campers and/or guests, loss of property or damage for any reason including fire, theft or acts of nature.
26. Camper's Holiday reserves the right to seek compensation for vandalism or destruction of Camper's Holiday property.
27. Safety – in the event of a rare tornado, the safest buildings to go to are the restrooms, not the Recreation Hall.
